## Ingredients

Caprylic/capric triglyceride, octyldodecanol, talc, cyclopentasiloxane, ricinus, communis (castor) seed oil, cyclohexasiloxane, euphorbia cerifera (candelilla) wax, ozokerite, copernicia cerifera (carnauba) wax, methyl methacrylate/glycol dimethacrylate crosspolymer, microcrystalline wax (cera microcristallina), algae extract, ethoxydiglycol, stabilised aloe vera gel extract, glycine soja (soybean) oil, water, propylene glycol, stearoxy dimethicone, stearammonium hectorite, propylene carbonate, tocopheryl acetate, butylparaben, propylparaben, [+/- (may contain): titanium dioxide (CI 77891), iron oxides (CI 77491, 77492, 77499), chromium hydroxide green (CI 77289), ultramarines (CI 77007), manganese violet (CI 77742)].

## Directions

After applying Sonya Cream to Powder Foundation, apply Concealer with your ring finger or sponge. Pat lightly around the eye area. Set Concealer in place with the Sonya Translucent Powder of your choice for a flawless finish.
